River Cruises

Similar to an ocean cruise, river cruises can be great for seeing multiple locations and cover a lot of ground in a short amount of time. River cruises can still have pools, multiple lounges, restaurants, spas and activities, although on a much smaller scale. And of course, river cruises need a river to travel, so they require a large river. Most river cruises will be found in Europe.

- Usually only buffet for breakfast and lunch with dining room only in the evening





Group Escorted Land Tours

Group escorted land tours are an excellent way to discover the world with ease. Your vacation will be led by a tour director with the same group of people throughout the tour and mainly travel by bus with washroom facilities. This type of vacation provides exceptional value with a set daily itinerary with accommodations, sightseeing activities, and meals together. They also can be a way for single people who dislike solo travel to experience places they wouldn't otherwise.
